Facts About Sexual Assault In North Dakota January – December 2012

- ❖ 919 primary victims and 416 secondary victims were served by 21 sexual assault crisis centers throughout North Dakota.
- ❖ At least **355(39%)** of primary victims were under the age of 18 years old at the time of the assault/s.
- ❖ At least **807(88%)** of the **victims** were **female.**
- ❖ At least 875 (95%) of the assailants were male.
- ***** 76% of the crimes were reported to law enforcement.
- ❖ At least 51% of <u>adult</u> victims contacted a sexual assault center about the crime within 2 days of the assault. 19% of <u>adult</u> victims contacted a sexual assault center within 3-30 days after the assault.
- ❖ At least 84% (776) of the cases were male assailant/female victim.
- ❖ At least 11% (99) of the cases were male assailant/male victim.
- ❖ At least 70% of the adult assaults were rape, 7% attempted rape, and 23% were sexual contact other than rape or attempted rape.
- ❖ In adult cases 12% of the assailants were strangers. In child cases 2% of the assailants were strangers.
- ❖ In at least 39% of all cases the assailant was a friend/acquaintance/date of the victim.
- ❖ At least 29% of all cases were incest or indicated a history of incest. In at least 7% of adult sexual assault cases reported, the victim also experienced sexual abuse/incest as a child.
- ❖ At least **9,434** services to **primary victims** were provided by crisis center advocates from January to December 2012.
- ❖ At least 37% of the assaults occurred in the victim's or assailant's home.
- ❖ At least 37% of the victims were **referred** to sexual assault service providers by **themselves**, **friends**, **or family members**.
