33% of adult victims contacted a sexual assault center about the crime within 2 days of the assault. 16% of adult victims contacted a sexual assault center within 3-30 days after the assault. 2018Case by Case

At least **63%** of the adult assaults were rape, **8%** attempted rape, and **29%** were sexual contact other than rape or attempted rape.

At least **403** of primary victims were under the age of 18 years old at the time of the assault/s.

In adult cases **12%** of the assailants were strangers. In child cases **2%** of the assailants were strangers.

In at least **40%** of all cases the assailant was a friend/acquaintance/date of the victim.

At least **35%** of the assaults occurred in the victim's or assailant's home.

26% of new victims were people with disabilities.
Of those 24% were people with developmental disabilities, 18% had physical disabilities and
51% were people with mental health disabilities.



At least 12,286 services to primary victims were provided by crisis center advocates from January to December 2018.

At least 24% of the victims were referred to sexual assault service providers by themselves, friends or family members.
